Recurring Transport

- Periodic support paid in regular instalments direct from the NDIS to your nominated bank account. Contributes to the cost of accessing transport support.

## 1. Assistance with Daily Living

- Home and garden maintenance
- Showering and dressing support
- Support Workers



## 2. Transport

- Transport can help you access taxis or ubers for your personal supports, such as attending therapy appointments



## 3. Consumables

- Continence products
- Sensory items
- Modified cutlery
- Low cost, low risk assistive technology



## 4. Assistance with Social, Economic & Community Participation

- Support worker to attend an event or activity with you
- Attending day programs or group activities



## 5. Assistive Technology

- Wheelchairs
- Prosthetics
- Braille related resources
- Vehicle Modifications incl. hand controls, wheelchair lifts and ramps, seat modifications



## 6. Home Modifications

- Shower rails
- Wheelchair ramps
- A project manager to oversee the modifications



## 17. Specialised Disability Accommodation (SDA)

- This funds specialist housing that assists people who have high physical support needs and funds the homes services are delivered in.

- Rental of Assistive Technology
- Repairs and Maintenance of Assistive Technology

### 7. Support Coordinators & Psychosocial Recovery Coaches

- Support Coordinator
- Mental Health Recovery Coach

### 8. Improved Living Arrangements

- Financial counselling
- Support workers to attend house inspections with you
- Support negotiating contracts

### 9. Increased Social & Community Participation

- Life Skills Coaching
- Sports Coaching
- Mentor to help build independence

### 10. Finding & Keeping a Job

- Resume writing support
- Support at job interviews
- Support moving from school to work

### 11. Relationships

- Support to develop skills for participation in community and social activities

### 12. Health & Wellbeing

- Dietician
- Personal Trainer
- Exercise Physiologist

### 13. Life Long Learning

- Advice on further education
- Support with applications to further education organisations
- Support at orientation events

### 14. Choice & Control

- This budget can be used to fund a plan manager, like NDSP, to pay your provider invoices and is added to your plan.

- Occupational Therapy
- Early Childhood Intervention Strategies

- Specialist Behavioural Intervention Support
